

8 At A Time Half Square Triangles

Instructions:


- 1. Cut (1) square of each of the 2 fabrics in the HST, in the size needed based on the chart located on Page 2
- 2. Draw 2 diagonal lines from corner to corner on the wrong side of the lightest square. Draw lines across the horizontal center and down the vertical center of the square also.



- 3. Place squares right sides together with the marked square on top. Pin as needed.
- 4. Sew on both sides of each DIAGONAL line using a scant ¼" seam allowance.




5. Cut on ALL marked lines.





- 6. Press each HST with seam toward the darker fabric unless otherwise specified in your pattern.
- 7. Square up each HST to the correct size needed to sew into your quilt block (unfinished size).



Quick reference chart for what sizes of squares are needed to make 8 Half Square Triangles

Unfinished*	Finished	Square Size
Block Size	Block Size	to Cut
1-1/2"	1"	4"
2-1/2"	2"	6"
3-1/2"	3"	8"
4-1/2"	4"	10"
5-1/2"	5"	12"
6-1/2"	6"	14"
7-1/2"	7"	16"
8-1/2"	8"	18"

^{*}Unfinished block size = Size of block prior to sewing blocks together for finished project.
